

Dear Mr. Kaulukukui:

This is a follow up to our recent correspondence dated April 5, 2018. Per the Co-Trustees, the amended tax returns have been processed and the state refund received from the State of Hawaii is \$35,388.90 and the federal refund received from the IRS is \$175,525.64. After depositing the refunds into the trust account, the available balance is \$1,090,005.35. As you are aware, the Final Accounts approved by the Court puts aside a reserve of \$51,583.59. Based on this, the amount available for distribution is \$1,038,421.76 (\$1,090,005.35 - \$51,583.59). Accordingly, the final distribution amount for each of the 20 beneficiaries is \$51,921.08. Your check in the amount of \$51,921.08 along with a personal letter from the Co-Trustees is enclosed. Please note that when all final expenses have been paid, the Co-Trustees will distribute any remaining balance of the reserve equally to the 20 beneficiaries.

We thank you for your continued patience during the course of this administration.
