

[PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 52 \(2018\)](#) – (Submitted by Councilmember Fukunaga) – The CD1 (OCS2018—0700/7/18/2018 2:00 PM) makes the following amendments:

- A. Adds a new subsection (d) providing that the proposed new article does not apply to any person engaging in an activity pursuant to a permit or license issued by the State, the City, or federal government.
- B. Adds a new SECTION 3 to the bill to provide that the ordinance would take effect upon its approval.
- C. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments, including amendments to correct grammatical and typographical errors, improve clarity, and conform the bill to recommended drafting style.
