Listed as follows:

1. Kalihi-uka - Business District. Approved
2. School and Gulick - Business District. Disapproved but passed by Board over veto of Mayor.
3. Kapiolani Boulevard and Atkinson Drive- not completed.
4. Citron and Haole - Business District. Not approved.
5. Beretania and Punahou - Dropped because of protests.
6. Kapiolani Boulevard- Industrial District- one unit. Approved.
7. King Street Extension at Waialae- replacing abandoned portion of street. Approved.
8. Senate Bill No. 80 in re decrease in boundaries of Fire District No. 2. Approved.
9. South and Queen Streets- Industrial use for Brewery purposes. Approved.
10. Beretania and Alapai- Bond Building- Industrial Use for brewery purposes. Not approved. Continued by Board of Supervisors, but withdrawn by owners because of opposition.
11. University and Dole Street, at University of Hawaii. Business District. Approved.
