**FOR ACTION**

1. **[BILL 34 \(2019\)](#) – RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF CLIMATE CHANGE, SUSTAINABILITY AND RESILIENCY.** Requiring the Office of Climate Change, Sustainability and Resiliency to track and report annually on Oahu visitor industry sustainability efforts as a way to encourage that industry to adopt sustainable eco-tourism policies whenever possible, with the aim of reducing solid waste production, reducing water and fossil fuel use, and promoting options for cleaner energy and multi-modal transportation. (Bill passed first reading on 7/3/19; Committee postponed action on 7/23/19)

**[PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 34 \(2019\)](#)** (Submitted by Councilmember Pine) – The CD1 (OCS2020-0006/1/8/2020 10:23 AM) makes the following amendments:

- A. Amends the effective date provision in SECTION 3 by adding a proviso to allow the Executive to refrain from undertaking the directives enacted in SECTION 2 until funding to produce the initial annual report is available.
  - B. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.
2. **[BILL 51 \(2019\), CD1, FD1](#) – RELATING TO TOURISM.** Establishing a “Keep Hawaii Hawaii” pledge awareness program for visitors to the City and County of Honolulu, aimed at promoting visitor awareness and on-island behaviors that are environmentally responsible and culturally sensitive. (Bill 51, CD1, FD1 passed second reading and public hearing held on 11/6/19; Committee postponed action on 11/12/19)
