WHEREAS, Section 13-113 of the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu 1973 (2017 Edition), provides the City Council ("Council") with authority to accept gifts to the City; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 05-349, CD1, FD1, establishes a policy of the Council for the solicitation and acceptance of gifts donated to the City; and

WHEREAS, the policy provides for acceptance of a gift by administrative action by the Council; and

WHEREAS, through a letter, approved by the Managing Director, the Chief of Police has submitted a request to the Council for acceptance of a gift to the City from VCA Family and Oahu Veterinary Specialty Center of a surgical procedure valued at \$2,589.13 for an emergency surgery on Honolulu Police Department ("HPD") canine, Cache; and

WHEREAS, the description and value of the gift are set forth in the Declaration of Gift attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that this body accepts the gift valued at \$2,589.13 from VCA Family and Oahu Veterinary Specialty Center that is more fully described in the above-mentioned letter and the Declaration of Gift attached as Exhibit A; and
