Both Bills 46 (2018), CD1 involving the Haleiwa Special District and Bill 47 (2018), CD1 involving Mobile Commercial Establishments were re-referred on 5/13/19 to the new standing committees. Both Bills are scheduled for auto file on 7/2/20.
