

Dear Chair Anderson and Councilmembers:

SUBJECT: Reduction to Funding Available for Grants In Aid

Pursuant to Bill 20 (2020) CD1 FD1, funding available for non-profit grants via the Grants in Aid Fund (GIA) was reduced by \$479,000. One organization, the Armed Forced YMCA of Honolulu, will be awarded \$70,941 instead of the requested amount of \$91,208. Four non-profit organizations receiving the lowest scores, as recommended by the Grants in Aid Advisory Commission, will not receive any GIA funds.

- Honpa Hongwanji Hawaii Betsuin
- Healthy Mothers Healthy Babies
- Honolulu Community Action Program
- Protect and Preserve Hawaii

All other organizations will be contracted pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 6 Article 52 of the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu (1990). For your reference, please find attached Appendix 1, a funding reduction summary which shows how the funding reductions were applied, Appendix 2, which lists all recommended organizations in alphabetical order, and Appendix 3 which lists all applicants by score.
