### PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AND TESTIMONY

Pursuant to the Twelfth Proclamation issued by Governor David Ige on August 20, 2020, relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, in order to allow public participation in a manner consistent with social distancing practices the following procedures are in effect for the meeting:

### VIEWING THE MEETING AND RESTRICTIONS ON ENTRY

Some Councilmembers and presenters may be participating in the meeting by interactive conference technology from remote locations.

### ORAL TESTIMONY

Oral testimony will be permitted on all items on the agenda, subject to the following restrictions:

1. Persons may submit oral testimony remotely through the Webex internet platform. To participate, persons should visit [www.webex.com](http://www.webex.com), click "Join," enter meeting number **146 520 4918** and complete the registration process. Registrants will receive an email that contains links and information on joining the meeting by either phone or video conference. Webex testifiers are strongly encouraged to register at least 24 hours before the start of the meeting. Remote testimony will be taken at the start of the agenda and then closed.
2. Each speaker is limited to one-minute presentation.

**FOR ACTION**

1. **BILL 47 (2020) – RELATING TO CROSSWALKS.** Establishing requirements concerning the City Administration's provision or offer to provide a presentation to the affected neighborhood board prior to the removal or relocation of an established, marked crosswalk. (Committee postponed action on 7/8/20)

PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 47 (2020) (Submitted by Councilmember Waters) – The CD1 (OCS2020-0904/9/10/2020 3:45 PM) makes the following amendments:

- A. Page 2: Adds language to the end of subsection (b) to read:

"In addition, the written notice transmitted to the chair of the affected neighborhood board must include but not be limited to the rationale for the proposed change, viable options for the public to cross the roadway, and steps incorporated to increase public safety."

- B. Page 2: Adds the phrase "when possible" to the first sentence of subsection (c). In addition, adds language to the middle of subsection (c) to read:

"If a presentation cannot be made within 60 days of the transmittal of the offer, the reasoning and justification for a delayed presentation, along with a proposed subsequent time period for the presentation, shall be provided in writing to the chair of the affected neighborhood board."

- C. Page 2: Adds the conjunction "or" in subdivision (3) between the words "crosswalk" and "that."

- D. Page 2: Adds a new subdivision (4) to read:

"The director, or the director's designated subordinate, having previously provided written reasoning and justification for a delayed presentation to the chair of the affected neighborhood board, makes a presentation including the required elements before the affected neighborhood board at an agreed-upon date subsequent to the 60-day deadline of the transmittal of the notice."

- E. Page 3: Changes the effective date to July 1, 2021.

- F. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.

2. **RESOLUTION 20-204 – UPDATE TO THE OAHU BIKE PLAN.** Approving the December 2019 update to the Oahu Bike Plan and transmitting the Plan to the Oahu Metropolitan Planning Organization for incorporation into the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan. (Transmitted by Communication D-555)
