



RESOLUTION

URGING THE MAYOR TO APPOINT A COMMITTEE TO PLAN AND IMPLEMENT A CELEBRATION OF THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2004, the Council adopted Resolution 04-53, urging then Mayor Jeremy Harris to appoint a committee to plan and implement a 100th anniversary celebration of the establishment of the City and County of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, the resolution recognized that the year 2005 is the 100th anniversary of the passage of the County Act, the election of seven county supervisors and the subsequent formation of the City and County of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, the Council expressed its unanimous support for a countywide celebration, to include events such as educational events, community fairs, and reunions and recognition of citizens who have made an important contribution to the development of the city; and

WHEREAS, the Council also expressed its feeling that the planning and implementation tasks for such an anniversary celebration should involve the talents and vision of experienced community leaders, artists and residents who can create partnerships within the community and leverage funding resources from various government and private entities; and

WHEREAS, given the inauguration in the new year of the new mayor, Mufi Hannemann, the Council wishes to reaffirm its desire and commitment to a 100th anniversary celebration of the establishment of the City and County of Honolulu; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that the Mayor is urged to appoint a committee to plan and implement the celebration of the 100th anniversary of the City and County of Honolulu; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee be composed of twelve community members and professionals familiar with event planning, the history of Honolulu, and experience in developing community partnerships, six of whom shall be appointed by the Council and six to be appointed by the Mayor, and the chair to be chosen by the committee members; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is urged to submit a progress report on the establishment of the anniversary committee to the Council no later than 60

days after the adoption of this Resolution and send written communication to the Council naming the six mayoral appointees to the committee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this Resolution, the provisions of this Resolution shall supercede Resolution 04-53; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the copies of this Resolution be transmitted to Mayor and the Managing Director.




