A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

RELATING TO PERSONS WITH CONTRACTS WITH THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to require the city to prepare and make public a report identifying persons who have entered into contracts with the city, and who are precluded by the provisions of Act 203, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, from making campaign contributions to a political party, committee, or candidate or to any person for a political purpose or use, or from knowingly soliciting campaign contributions from any person for any purpose.

SECTION 2. Chapter 2, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, is amended by adding a new article to be appropriately designated by the revisor of ordinances and to read as follows:

"Article __. Contracts with City

Sec. 2-__ Reporting of persons with contracts with the city.

- (a) The department or agency designated by the mayor shall prepare and maintain a report identifying each person who entered into a contract with any executive agency and was, during the reporting period, subject to the prohibitions of HRS § 11-205.5(a), as amended by § 8 of Act 203, SLH 2005. The report shall be updated quarterly and shall be made available for public inspection no later than 30 days after the end of each quarter at the department or agency maintaining the report and at the office of the city clerk.
- (b) The council chair, or the chair's designee, shall prepare a report identifying each person who entered into a contract with any legislative agency and was, during the reporting period, subject to the prohibitions of HRS § 11-205.5(a), as amended by § 8 of Act 203, SLH 2005. The report shall be updated quarterly and shall be made available for public inspection no later than 30 days after the end of each quarter at the office of the city clerk.
- (c) The report required by subsections (a) and (b) shall contain, at a minimum, the following information:
 - (1) The name and business address of the person that has a contract with a city executive or legislative agency and is subject to the prohibitions of HRS § 11-205.5(a), as amended by § 8 of Act 203, SLH 2005; and
