



## RESOLUTION

RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF KIKA BUKOSKI TO SERVE ON THE LIQUOR COMMISSION OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

WHEREAS, Section 281-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), establishes a liquor commission for each county consisting of at least five members nominated by the county mayor and confirmed by the county council to five-year terms; and

WHEREAS, the major duties of the liquor commission are the following: granting and, if necessary, suspending or revoking liquor licenses; monitoring the operations of liquor licensees; adopting rules on the proper conduct of liquor manufacturers, importers, and sellers; and enforcing state laws and commission rules relating to liquor; and

WHEREAS, Section 281-11, HRS, establishes the following qualifications and disqualifications applicable to a liquor commission member:

- (1) A member must be a United States citizen;
- (2) A member must have resided in the county served by the commission for at least three years immediately preceding appointment;
- (3) A member cannot engage or hold a direct or indirect interest in "any business for the manufacture or sale of liquor";
- (4) A member cannot be an advocate or member of or identified or connected with "any organization or association which advocates prohibition";
- (5) A member cannot be an elected state or county officer or a candidate for a public office while on the commission; and
- (6) A member cannot belong to the same political party to which a quorum of other members already belongs;

and

WHEREAS, the Mayor through Mayor's Message OO9 (2006) has appointed Kika Bukoski to fill a vacancy and serve for a term ending on December 31, 2006 in succession of Danny Auyong; and

WHEREAS, based on its review of the appointee, the Council finds that Mr. Bukoski qualifies to serve on the Honolulu liquor commission and deserves confirmation; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that this body confirms the appointment of Kika Bukoski to the Honolulu liquor commission to serve for a term expiring on December 31, 2006; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to Mr. Bukoski for his willingness to be considered for public service and actively participate in city government; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, Chair of the Honolulu liquor commission, and Kika Bukoski.
