Your Committee on Executive Matters, to which was referred Resolution 07-004,
entitled:

FOR INDIVIDUAL PERMITS TO RECEIVE SHIPMENTS OF LIQUOR,” AND
§3-83-54.1, “FILING FEES,” OF THE RULES OF THE LIQUOR COMMISSION
OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU,”

transmitted by Communication D-1038/06, from Dewey H. Kim, Jr., Administrator,
Liquor Commission, dated December 28, 2006, reports as follows:

The purpose of this Resolution is to have the City Council review the resubmitted
Rules of the Liquor Commission of the City and County of Honolulu.

Pursuant to Resolution 05-034 FD1, which amended the rules of the Liquor
Commission relating to amending liquor license, trade name change, permit and filing
fees and providing for an effective date of July 1, 2005 or soon thereafter, a provision of
the resolution required the Liquor Commission resubmit the rules for reconsideration by
Council by December 31, 2006.

A representative of the Liquor Commission testified in support of the resolution,
stating that since the July 1, 2005, the Commission was able to implement the

increased license fee structure without incident and that no restructuring has occurred since then.

With the increased revenue the Commission was able to make immediate improvement including filling vacancies, reestablishing an audit section and increasing the number of license investigators, which has increased the speed of the application process.
