



A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

RELATING TO THE TRAFFIC CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the people of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the city traffic code to eliminate the minimum height requirement for auxiliary driving lamps. This amendment is intended to address the existing conflict between City ordinance and vehicles which are affixed with such equipment by the manufacturer at a height lower than the existing 12-inch minimum height requirement.

SECTION 2. Section 15-19.12, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

**"Sec. 15-19.12      Auxiliary Driving Lamps.**

A motor vehicle may be equipped with not more than three auxiliary driving lamps mounted on the front at a height not [less than 12 inches nor] more than 42 inches above the level surface upon which the vehicle stands, and every such auxiliary driving lamp or lamps shall meet the requirements and limitations set forth in this article.

SECTION 3. Ordinance material to be repealed is bracketed. New Material is underscored. When revising, compiling, or printing this ordinance for inclusion in the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu, the revisor of ordinances need not include the brackets, the bracketed material or the underscoring.
