

Dear Chair Marshall and Councilmembers:

Section 2-17.2(a) of the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu relating to the execution of the Executive Operating Budget authorizes the Mayor to establish, fill and allot funds for additional temporary positions that are not included in the Executive Operating Budget Ordinance, upon prior notification to the City Council. In accordance with the provisions of this ordinance, notification is hereby submitted for one (1) Trades Helper contract for the Department of Environmental Services, Division of Wastewater Treatment and Disposal. Additional required information on this position is as follows:

1. Type of Temporary Position Required:

One (1) Trades Helper for a maximum of six (6) months as allowed under Section 6-1103 (g) of the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu.

2. Anticipated Duration of the Employment of the Temporary Position:

July 1, 2008 – December 31, 2008

Possible extension/renewal as required and allowable under City Charter.

3. Cost of the Temporary Position:

\$31,000


4. Source of Budgetary Savings, Which Will Accrue to Finance the Temporary Position:

Funding to come from salary savings.

5. Unforeseen or Emergency Circumstances Justifying the Need for the Temporary Position:

There has been a lack of applicants to fill one vacancy at the authorized Plant Electrical/Electronic Equipment Repairer (PEEER) level. Contract services is the alternative to train recent community college graduates to acquire on-the-job training under the direction of a Senior PEEER to gain experience, knowledge, and the required journey level electrician's license to eventually qualify for the PEEER vacancy.


