

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Section 13-113 of the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu provides for the acceptance of gifts to the city by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 05-349, CD1, FD1, establishes a policy of the Council for the solicitation and acceptance of gifts donated to the City executive agencies; and

WHEREAS, the policy provides for acceptance of the gift by affirmative action by the Council; and

WHEREAS, through a letter dated June 18, 2008, the Police Chief of the Honolulu Police Department (hereinafter HPD) has submitted a request to the Council that was approved by the Managing Director for the acceptance of a gift from the Hawaii Family Support Institute valued at \$4,000 to send Detectives James Maurer and Herbert Soria of the Criminal Investigation Division to attend the Crimes Against Children Conference in Dallas, Texas, from August 11 through 14, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the description and value of the gift are set forth in the Declaration of Gift (Exhibit A) and incorporated herein; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that this body accepts the gift valued at \$4,000 that is more fully described in the above-mentioned letter from the Chief of Police of the HPD; and
