



A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

RELATING TO ENERGY STAR QUALIFIED PRODUCTS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. HRS Section 103D-410 requires the state to consider purchasing via the life-cycle costing method those classes of items for which nationally recognized energy efficiency data have been developed. HRS Section 196-23 requires state agencies, when life-cycle cost effective, to purchase ENERGY STAR and other energy efficient products when acquiring energy using products. Resolution 99-225, CD1, establishes a city policy to only purchase energy-consuming city office equipment that is ENERGY STAR compliant. The city auditor's report, Audit of the City's Electricity Costs, Consumption, and Management (Report No. 08-02, July 2008), recommends that the city support the purchase of ENERGY STAR-rated products.

The purpose of this ordinance is to require the city to purchase ENERGY STAR qualified products when such products are available and cost effective.

SECTION 2. Chapter 2, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, as amended, is amended by adding a new article to be appropriately designated by the revisor of ordinances and to read as follows:

"Article __. ENERGY STAR Products

Sec. 2-__1 Definitions.

For the purpose of this article:

"City" includes both the executive and legislative branches of the City and County of Honolulu.

"ENERGY STAR" is the joint program of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the United States Department of Energy designed to identify and promote energy efficient products.

"ENERGY STAR qualified product" means a product that has met strict energy efficiency guidelines set by the EPA and Department of Energy and is identified by the ENERGY STAR label.

Sec. 2-__2 Required procurement of ENERGY STAR qualified products.

- (a) Except as otherwise provided under subsection (b), when procuring products that are listed under the ENERGY STAR program, the city shall procure only ENERGY STAR qualified products.
- (b) The city may procure products not ENERGY STAR qualified under the following circumstances:
 - (1) No comparable product is ENERGY STAR qualified; or
 - (2) The life-cycle costs of all comparable ENERGY STAR qualified products are more than 105 percent of the life-cycle cost of a product that is not ENERGY STAR qualified.”
