

Subject: Request for Council Acceptance of a Gift to the City of Artwork

We respectfully request the acceptance by the Council on behalf of the City and County of Honolulu of a gift to the City from the Butterfly Society of Hawaii. The gift is a bronze sculpture manufactured by the Bronzemen of Los Angeles entitled, "Beautiful Butterflies." This request is made under the provisions of Resolution No. 05-349, CD1, FD1.

The Commission on Culture and the Arts, at its March 12, 2009 meeting, determined the acceptability of this gift and recommends the City Council accept this sculpture as a gift to the City. The Mayor's Office of Culture and the Arts desires placement of the gift, valued at \$3,203.79, in the Art in City Buildings collection of the City and County of Honolulu. RESOLUTION

THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GIFT OF ARTWORK FROM THE BUTTERFLY SOCIETY OF HAWAII TO THE CITY FOR THE ART IN CITY BUILDINGS COLLECTION OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU MANAGED BY THE MAYOR'S OFFICE OF CULTURE AND THE ARTS.

WHEREAS, the Butterfly Society of Hawaii desires to gift a sculpture to the City and County of Honolulu entitled, "Beautiful Butterflies" by the Bronzemen; the bronze sculpture depicts a seated girl with outstretched arms holding butterflies and sits 28 inches high, and was manufactured in Los Angeles; to be installed in the Butterfly Habitat Garden of Foster Botanical Garden; and

WHEREAS, the Butterfly Society of Hawaii was established in 2005, and is a 501(c)(3) organization registered with the Internal Revenue Service and the State of Hawaii; and

WHEREAS, on July 19, 2007, the Butterfly Society of Hawaii entered an agreement with the City and County of Honolulu to create and maintain a Butterfly Habitat Garden at Foster Botanical Garden; the Butterfly Habitat Garden is an outdoor, open-air butterfly habitat that serves as a living classroom to educate the public about the interdependence between butterflies, plants, and people; the Butterfly Habitat Garden also provides a home to Hawaii's 17 butterfly species; and

WHEREAS, the Commission on Culture and the Arts approved to respectfully request the acceptance of this gift by the Council on their meeting of March 12, 2009; and

WHEREAS, Section 13-113 of the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu provides for the acceptance of gifts to the City by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 05-349, CD1, FD1, establishes a policy of the Council for the solicitation and acceptance of gifts donated to the City executive agencies; and

WHEREAS, the policy provides for acceptance of the gift by affirmative action by the Council; and

WHEREAS, through a letter dated March 30, 2009, the Executive Director of the Mayor's Office of Culture and the Arts, has submitted a request to the Council (and approved by the Managing Director) of the gift valued at \$3,203.79 for the Art in City Buildings collection; and,



RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the description and value of the gift are set forth in the Declaration of Gift attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that this body accept the gift valued at \$3,203.79 from the Butterfly Society of Hawaii; and


