

CIP Funding and the Kahalu'u Pedestrian and Bicycle Network Circulation Study

It was very disappointing to hear the CIP funding for the study and design of the Pedestrian and Bicycle Network is not being included in the present budget. Understanding that the economy is in difficult straights, the present lack of funding seems to be a continuation of the lack of commitment to the development of meaningful bicycling alternatives on the Windward side.

Although great pronouncements have been made in the past, we have yet to see meaningful actions taken to provide bicycle pathways. Even when work is being undertaken on Windward roads, panning for the integration of bicycle concerns is seldom included, even when the added cost would be minimal

Once again, actions to address the health, safety and welfare of the Windward citizens are being postponed and delayed.
