



RESOLUTION

RELATING TO THE WORK OF THE COMMISSION ON CLEAN WATER AND NATURAL LANDS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to city charter amendments (charter section 9-204.1) ratified by the voters in 2006, and the council's enactment of enabling legislation (ROH chapter 6, article 62), the council has adopted Resolution 07-355, CD1, establishing the commission on clean water and natural lands, which among its duties and responsibilities is to develop funding priorities to carry out the purposes of the clean water and natural lands fund created by the charter amendment; and

WHEREAS, to carry out the intent of the fund in a fair and equitable manner, the council finds that it is necessary to clearly articulate and establish funding priorities to ensure the city's ability to purchase or otherwise acquire real estate or any interest in that real estate for land conservation; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that the funding priorities for the clean water and natural lands fund are all of the purposes stated in Resolution 07-355, which shall be considered equally and not ranked in any particular order as follows:

- Protection of watershed lands to preserve water quality and water supply;
- Preservation of forests, beaches, coastal areas and agricultural lands;
- Public outdoor recreation and education, including access to beaches and mountains;
- Preservation of historic or culturally important land areas and sites;
- Protection of significant habitat for ecosystems, including buffer zones;
- Conservation land in order to reduce erosion, floods, landslides and runoff; and
- Acquisition of public access to public land and open space;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the council finds that the advisory work of the commission on clean water and natural lands has been consistent with the provisions of Resolution 07-355, CD1; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the chair of the commission on clean water and natural lands.




