

Subject: Sixth Extension of Time Request for Bill 8 (2008)

The Department of Planning and Permitting (DPP) respectfully requests a 90-day extension of time for the above bill, to amend the Land Use Ordinance regarding regulation of certain visitor accommodations, i.e., transient vacation units. Bill 8 (2008) is the alternative ordinance proposed by the DPP to the bill initiated by Council Resolution 05-186, CD1.

Bill 8 passed the First Reading on February 20, 2008. At its February 10, 2009 meeting, the Zoning Committee recommended that a 90-day extension of time be granted for Bill 8 (2008). The City Council approved the extension to June 7, 2009. At its May 12, 2009 meeting, the Zoning Committee recommended that a 90-day extension of time be granted for the bill. The City Council approved the extension to September 5, 2009. At its June 30, 2009 meeting, the Zoning Committee recommended that another 90-day extension of time be granted for Bill 8 (2008), subject to the receipt of a written request from the DPP. The extension of time to December 4, 2009 will provide the City Council, including the two new councilmembers, with more time to consider the proposed ordinance.
