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





**Question 4. Department of Budget and Fiscal Services  
Real Property Assessment Division  
Provide information on RPT services provided to neighbor  
island counties, and revenues received from those counties.**

Answer:

RPT services, include the development and maintenance of an appraisal manual; the development and maintenance of a building classification manual; training and technical support for valuation methodology, including market modeling, cost, and reconciliation; and technical support for standards, procedures, and reports, including any non-appraisal manuals, relating to system-wide quality controls. RPT services also include educational training on-site for the counties at additional cost (time and materials basis), if requested, subject to the City's staffing and workload concerns. Other services include leading and coordinating the efforts to amend the HRS to resolve issues of state-wide concern, coordinating and hosting of the annual BOR conference, and responding to daily requests for consultation concerning ownership and mapping issues

Annual revenue from the counties for the next two years:

\$58,560
